April Donations Breakdown:

A total of \$1,520 CAD was sent to Yemen and was disbursed as follows:

- \$300 CAD dedicated to the monthly allowances for the three regular families (\$100 CAD / ~ 70,000 rials for each family):
 - Transfer fee was \$8 CAD.
 - Marsilya confirmed receipt of this transfer and has delivered April allowances to the three families.
 - <u>The impact of your donations</u>: Ms. Haddad who is one of the recipients of the monthly allowances is divorced and currently lives with her mother. She suffers from acute urinary tract diseases and requires weekly treatment sessions that cost 20,000 rials each. She doesn't have a source of income which makes covering these expenses very challenging. The monthly allowance has been helping her cover many of her medical expenses for which Marsilya has shared receipts with us.

• \$200 CAD (142,500 rials) dedicated to supporting:

- The family of a single mother and 3 children whom we shared information about in previous monthly emails and to whom your donations helped pay the childrens' school fees.
 - <u>The impact of your donations</u>: 130,000 rials was used to pay the family's debt at their local grocery store. The mother sent her thanks and said that your help was instrumental in reducing the family's burdens.
- Asalah: a 10-year-old girl who is living in poverty. Asalah is neglected and lives in a home that lacks basic necessities. Although the identity of her father is known, and he is able to support her if he chooses to, he has denied that he is her biological father and doesn't currently support her financially. Asalah's mother begs on the streets and leaves Asalah either on the street or with her aunt.
 - <u>The impact of your donations</u>: 24,600 rials are dedicated to help Asalah. Please note that this amount also includes 8,100 rials that remained in surplus with Marsilya from previous donations. Marsilya hasn't had a chance to meet with Asalah yet, but once she does, we will update you.

• \$990 CAD dedicated to supporting a father of 6 girls in Sana'a for opening a grocery store:

 This case was identified from contacts in Sana'a who work closely with families in need in supporting them to establish sustainable sources of income. The transfer was completed last week and hasn't yet been delivered to the family. Our contact in Yemen will be working closely with the family and supporting them throughout the process as well as providing regular updates and receipts as needed. Once we receive new updates, we will share them with you.
