1. Projects Generating Steady Income:

Selected Project: The father owns a commuter bus and needed money to repair and register the bus. The bus will generate steady income for the family.

Amount sent: 200,000 rials

Update: Unfortunately, our volunteers in Sana'a are still facing the same delays and are unable to register the bus. We have communicated with our team in Sana'a a deadline of Nov 30, 2021. If they are unable to register the bus by that date, our board will review re-allocating the donation to a different beneficiary.

Selected Project: Buna Ali, a mother of five, has used the donations to expand her business of selling dresses.

Amount sent this month: Monthly allowance of \$100 CAD

Update: We have been receiving positive updates from our volunteer in Aden regarding Buna Ali. She has been setting up her clothes stand relentlessly every day and is continually demonstrating resilience and hard work. In addition to the capital cost provided to Buna's business, we promised a monthly allowance of \$100 CAD for a duration of 6 months to alleviate some of her family's financial worries and aid her in focusing on her new business.

New Project: We have received info from our volunteer Marsilya in Lahij of a potential financial self-reliance candidate. We will be reviewing the info in our upcoming board meeting on Nov 29, 2021 and communicating the decision and next steps in our following email.

2. <u>Immediate Relief:</u>

New Candidate: 12-year-old girl diagnosed with leukemia.

Amount sent: \$450 CAD

Update: A one-time donation of \$450 CAD has been sent to the father of the girl diagnosed with leukemia on Nov 1st, 2021. The family are currently in Egypt for the girl's treatment and in need of \$25,000 USD to cover her treatment cost. They were able to collect \$15,000 USD but still in need of \$11,000 USD to cover the rest of the costs.
